The name of this week's פרשה is חיי שרה, literally the "life of שרה" As explained by the Alter Rebbe, the Hebrew name of a particular object or creation is what gives it its vitality and sustains it. Thus we must conclude that the entire פרשה is somehow connected with the life of

This, however, appears difficult to understand at first glance. Only the first poo of the פרשה relates to ישרה sife, whereas the rest of it speaks of seemingly unrelated matters: the marriage of יצחק and the passing of אברהם Why then is the entire portion known as Chayei שרה? The answer is that in truth, all of the events related in יצחק the marriage of יצחק and יצחק as well as the passing of אברהם express the sum and substance of our Matriarch in the sum and substance of sum and sum and

Concerning the marriage of יצחק and רבקה the Torah tells us, "And יצחק brought her into the tent of שרה his mother, and took חבקה, and she became his wife." When did יצחק agree to marry agree to marry? Only after he brought her into his mother's tent, and the miracles that used to occur during resumed.

explains that there were three specific miracles: 1) the שבת candles שרה kindled burned from one Friday afternoon till the next; 2) the dough she kneaded was specially blessed, and; 3) a cloud of holiness hovered over her tent. After 'שבה passing these miracles ceased; in the merit of רבקה, they returned.

This occurred three years after שרה passed away, yet we see in these miracles a continuation of her life.

A similar connection exists to the passing of our forefather אברהם. The Torah states, "His sons יצחק and ישמעא-ל buried him." יצחק is mentioned before אברהם for by the time אברהם passed away, משנא-ל By giving his ישמעא-ל By giving his younger brother precedence, ישמעא-ל demonstrated that the birthright rightly belonged to him.

This development was in the sole merit of שרה who when she saw that ישמעא-ל was "mocking," i.e., not behaving properly, demanded that אברהם "cast him out...for he will not be heir." ישמעא-ל intent was for ישמעא-ל to return to 'ח, which indeed subsequently occurred. Many years later, after שרה was no longer alive, אים alowed his younger brother to lead the way, again an expression of the continuation of 'שרה' life.

The entire פרשה is therefore known as חיי שרה as all of the events it relates are connected to 'שרה' life.

We have many Neshek packets in school! How can you receive Neshek to give out?


Every week we will be sending a slip of paper for you to fill out to let us know how many you want to take for Mivtzoim, and we will send it home with your daughter on Friday.
